High School Online Courses: AP, honors, and standard level high school courses are available through the North Carolina Virtual Public School (NCVPS) for students who have scheduling conflicts or are seeking to take courses not offered locally. Approval for these courses must occur through the guidance office. NCVPS course availability is limited. Students are expected to enroll in face-to-face courses if the course is available at the school. Students will be scheduled into the online lab each day for the duration of the online high school course. EOCs will be administered for any online course requiring an EOC. Students are required to meet the Rutherford County Schools Accountability Standards for all online courses.

Recovery Courses (tested and non-tested): These courses are for students who have failed a high school course. Recovery courses are available on a limited basis.
